

Code of Ethics

All coaches and parents are responsible for conducting themselves and their players/children in such a way as to attain the objectives and purpose of this organization. Negative comments will not be tolerated at KYA events be it towards coaches, officials, opposing teams or other parents.

If any coach or parent is found guilty of any misconduct such as fighting, intoxication, using abusive language, breaking or abusing any governing rules or behavior which the Board deems inappropriate, either in basketball, baseball, softball, football, cheerleading or drill team, at game sites, practice sites or team gatherings of any kind, including business meetings, disciplinary action will be taken or removal may be enforced by the Board of Directors, through the recommendation of the league commissioner or a KYA Board Member.

If a coach is in violation of any of the above offenses and is removed from his or her duties, he/she must sit out for one full year. If a coach must leave his or her team for any reason, the first assistant coach will take over the team.
